It might be someone you live with or someone you haven't seen in awhile.</p> <p>Letter Writing Paper</p>	<p>Go on a shape scavenger hunt. See if you can find the following shapes in or around your home.</p> <p>Circle, Square, Rectangle, Triangle, Rhombus, Hexagon</p> <p>Shapes: Parent Resource</p> <p>Have an adult take a picture of you on your scavenger hunt to share with your teacher through email or Facebook.</p> <p>Challenge: Describe the shapes by telling the number of corners and sides.</p>	 <p>Optimism</p> <p>Optimism: When you do something new you think "I can try", and give it your best shot because that's how you grow.</p> <p>Talk with your family about ways you have been or can be optimistic.</p>	 <p>Write the letters in your name on different pieces of scrap paper.</p> <p>Find one thing in your home that begins with each letter. Then find one thing that has the same ending sound as letters in your name.</p> <p>Challenge: Write each object's name.</p> <p>ABC Chart</p>	<p>Go outside with a family member, write a list of living and nonliving things that you find. Talk about how you know if something is living.</p> <p>Living and Nonliving Recording Sheet Parent Resource</p> <p>Bonus: Sing this Living Things song.</p> 
 <p>Play Monster Squeeze with someone in your family.</p> <p>Monster Squeeze Directions and Game Pieces</p>	<p>Write out your name. Review the vowel chart. How many vowels does your name have?</p> <p>Do this with other family member's names.</p> <p>Vowel Chart</p> <p>Challenge: Count how many vowels are in your name and how many consonants are in your name. Write a number sentence. (consonants + vowels = total letters in your name.)</p> <p>Example: Max (2+1 =3)</p>	<p>What will the weather be like on your birthday?
