**Question and Answer Time**



- Milan Area Schools is planning a return to **a Primary model of In-Person Instruction 5 Days a Week**  
(secondary options may be developed)
- First Day of School: August 30, 2021
- Last Day of School: June 10, 2022 (projected)
- Winter Break: December 20-31, 2021
- Spring Break: March 28 - April 1, 2022
- Other Breaks are TBD



- Cleaning protocols, sanitizing protocols, and other mitigation strategies will continue to be implemented.
  - Students will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before/after eating and when entering each classroom.
  - Schools will be cleaned and sanitized nightly (including student desks).
- **If required by MDHHS**, students and staff will wear facial coverings.

# Social Distancing



- We do not know if social distancing will be required; however, we can state that six feet of social distancing will not be able to be enforced throughout the building.
- Social distancing in classrooms will be maximized, but the reality in many cases will be two to three feet of separation between students/desks.
- **If required by MDHHS**, we will provide three feet of social distancing in the lunchroom while students are eating. (using every other seat)

# Health Expectations



## **STUDENTS WILL NEED TO STAY HOME WHEN THEY ARE SICK.**

- Families should check for COVID symptoms each and every morning
- Separate space for symptomatic students will be used at school until they can be picked up
- Timely pick up will be required for ill students

- Class Size: 25-30 students

# Lunch



- Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria and other designated lunch spaces.
- **If required by MDHHS,** students will be seated 3 feet apart (using every other seat) when possible. We will have decals on the tables to show students where to sit.

# Daily Schedule



- Students will return to a normal daily schedule with all students in attendance.
- Students will attend all 7 class periods each day
- 7:30 AM - 2:11 PM
- Students will be allowed to enter the building earlier and stay later than during COVID
