Students

- Second Semester Instructional Model Shifts (start January 19th)
 - All requests were granted. (a few families withdrew their request when contacted)
 - \circ 47 students made request to switch from hybrid to virtual.
 - 71 students made request to switch from virtual to hybrid.
- Our Girls Swimming and Diving Team has 9 girls attending the State meet this Saturday. We wish the athletes and their coaches the best of luck!
- Congratulations to the MHS Football program. The team ended their season as District Champions after losing a tough fought game for the Regional Championship last Saturday.
- The current MDHHS Pandemic Order prohibits indoor contact sport competitions through January 31st. This includes basketball, wrestling, and ice hockey. Practices are allowed under very specific safety requirements. We believe that Boys Swimming and Diving will be allowed to practice and compete. The potential for our Bowling Team to compete and/or practice will depend on the MDHHS orders regarding bowling alley restrictions.
