Superintendent's Comments:

Staff

• On Thursday (10-25-18), Superintendent Girbach will be hosting the new teachers for Session I of the New Teacher Orientation program. He is excited to begin working with the new teachers as they become an integral part of Milan Area Schools.

General

• Tom Holden (retired Milan Area Schools teacher) passed away on.

Communication

- The district currently has 749 Twitter followers. That is up 7 from last meeting.
- The district currently has 1,563 Facebook followers. That is up 4 from last meeting.

Budget

- The sale of the 2019 bonds that will refinance our 2009 Bonds went very well. The stock market down-turn the night before helped us with the rates. We also had between 2 and 4 times the offers at each maturity date which allowed us to lower the interest between 2 and 4 basis points. The projected savings from the refinancing are \$2.7 million on the bonds and \$1.6 million on School Bond Loan Fund interest for a total projected savings of \$4.3 million. This is great news for our taxpayers.
- Our BCBS insurance illustrative rates are now finalized. Our annual rates dropped by:

\$218.40 for Single Coverage \$807.76 for Two Person Coverage \$1,063.32 for Full Family Coverage

Employees who use the district's insurance will recognize a percentage of the savings through a decrease in their percentage contribution towards the illustrative rate.

Goal Work

• The Diversity Team met on Thursday (10-18-18). The Team also attended the first session of the Advanced Justice Leaders Program that day. The Team has reviewed the Board's District/Superintendent Diversity Priority and is working on the deliverables of that goal.

Assistant Superintendent's Report:

• Assistant Superintendent McMahon shared that two grant applications were recently submitted through MDE. The Additional Instructional Time Grant and the Assessment Reimbursement Grant are both in submission stage awaiting approval.
