General

• MAS in partnership with EMU and numerous other entities have been approved for final application for a Marshall Plan Grant. Principal Shinn and Superintendent Girbach have been working with EMU on the application. Grant announcements will be made on December 17th. If the grant is approved, Milan will receive up to \$500,000 in teacher training and supplies to support engineering and manufacturing curriculum.

Communication

- The district currently has 766 Twitter followers. That is up 10 from last meeting.
- The district currently has 1,581 Facebook followers. That is up 6 from last meeting.

Budget

- During the months of January and February, following the December Budget Revision, the Board will be discussing facility needs, technology needs, curricular needs, and staff compensation.
- The recent bond refinancing is now complete. The transaction is estimated to save Milan taxpayers \$4,332,000 in interest expenses over the next 25 years.

- Assistant Superintendent McMahon shared that MAS was awarded the full amount of their robotics grant application, a total of \$6,450 shared amongst all four buildings.
- Assistant Superintendent McMahon shared highlights from the building PD sessions that were held today.
- Assistant Superintendent McMahon formally thanked Dr. Peacock for his 12 years of service to MAS as a member of the BOE.
