Superintendent's Comments:

Students

- The district wants to remind our students and families that meals continue to be provided for free to all children under the age of 18. The provision of free food will continue through the end of the school year. A link to place food orders can be found on the main page of milanareaschools.org. Orders are taken each week between Wednesday morning and noon on Thursday. Orders are filled between 4:00 and 5:00 PM on Tuesdays behind Milan High School. The federal program does not include free milk as a separate item. The federal government is only reimbursing for free meal equivalents (meaning a full lunch).
- Athlete testing continues to go well with only 2 positive results out of approximately 200 tests last week. Robert Hull (Athletic Director) and Rebecca McLeod (Athletic Trainer) have been doing a great job of implementing the testing regimen. We thank our athletes and parents for cooperating with the required testing protocols.
- SAVE THE DATE! Milan Area Schools and the Washtenaw County health Department will be hosting a Pfizer and Johnson and Johnson vaccination clinic on Tuesday, May 25th from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM in the Milan High School cafeteria. Appointments will

- be available for anyone 12 years old or older! Individuals 17 years old or younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Visit milanareaschools.org to schedule an appointment.
- The planning for our K-8 Summer School and 9-12 Credit Recovery Programs continues. We have completed a staff interest survey, staff compensation plans are in place, and program details have been outlined. This week, Administrators will begin meeting with the staff members involved and will begin making more detailed plans. In the near future, we will begin inviting student participants.

- As we continue to plan for a return to 5-days a week of in-person instruction for the 2021-2022 school year, the Administrative Team will be conducting building specific informational zoom sessions for families. These sessions will provide families with details about the 2021-2022 school year. Dates and times will be released soon.
