## **Superintendent's Comments:**

#### **Students**

- The Milan High School baseball team was named one of six Division 2 All State Academic Teams. The district congratulates the boys on an outstanding academic school year!
- In September, the Board will be recognizing the Boys' Track team and Girls' Softball team for their athletic accomplishments this year.

## **Staff**

- Mary Jo Hess (MMS ELA Teacher) announced her retirement effective June 30, 2017. The district thanks her for her years of service. Superintendent Girbach and Mr. McMahon will be honoring Mrs. Hess by meeting with her and her husband to personally thank her for her service and to deliver her official plaque.
- Aaron Miller (Buildings and Grounds Director) lost his mother last week.
- Renee Pesheck (Paddock Teacher) will not be returning to Milan Area Schools next year.
- Jill Carey (MMS Teacher) will not be returning to Milan Area Schools next year.
- Lon Smith, Krissy Collier, and Superintendent Girbach attended a legal seminar regarding new Student Discipline, Seclusion, and Restraint laws. They then met with the entire Administrative team to make sure that the buildings' student handbooks are aligned to the requirements of the new laws. The district will also be providing training to all employees regarding the new requirements.
- The first round of negotiations with the MEA went very well. The 2017-2018 calendar was discussed and is close to being finalized. Both sides shared some ideas regarding language changes. The next meeting will begin the process of discussing salary and health care.
- Kimberly Gillow, Sean DeSarbo, Ryan McMahon, and Superintendent Girbach have been meeting regarding elementary staffing levels. Ongoing conversations revolve around the number of incoming kindergarteners and the effect the count might have on 2017-2018 K-5 teacher needs.

#### General

• The district's annual advertising campaign will include a postcard mailing, a banner in Briarwood Mall, a banner in High Velocity, and radio spots on W4 Country. The program is aligned with the strengths of Milan Area Schools (safety, relationships, academics, athletics, extra-curricular, and early literacy). We are inviting everyone to come take a personal tour of our schools with the principals.

#### Communication

- The district currently has 522 Twitter followers. That is up 0 from last meeting.
- The district currently has 1,327 Facebook followers. That is up 2 from last meeting.

#### **Budget**

• Superintendent Girbach met with the district's Kapnick representative to begin exploring BCBS health care options for the district's employee groups. Girbach should have good information prior to the next negotiation date with the MEA. The goal is to decrease the employee contribution without increasing the district's cost or drastically affecting the level of coverage.

#### **Legislative**

- The final school-aid-budget is possibly going to be slightly better than the conference report that was shared last week. The highlights for Milan include:
  - \$120 per pupil foundation increase
  - \$25 per 9-12 grade pupil foundation increase
  - \$137,089 in additional at-risk funding
  - unknown effect of MPSERS changes
